Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Melbourne Yacht Club.

Rules: This regatta is governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing

Entry and Eligibility: This Regatta is open to all female sailors with a monohull sailboat over 20 feet in length. PHRF classes are open to boats with a PHRF rating or an equivalent issued by the MYC race committee. A male owner or male representative is allowed onboard during races but will be restricted as defined in the sailing instructions.

Entry fees, per boat:

Adults \$50, Includes, racing, awards, beverages and snacks.

Sailing Area: The Indian River Lagoon, south of the Rt. 192 Causeway.

Races: Up to 2 races are scheduled for PHRF classes. Up to 4 races are scheduled for the J-24 division. Completion of 1 race constitutes a regatta.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and a copy will be posted on the Notice Board in the main hall of MYC.

Courses: PHRF classes will sail distance courses utilizing temporary inflatable marks and Govt. marks. The J-24 course will be windward-leeward courses. Courses, marks and order of rounding's shall be as shown in the sailing instructions and accompanying Appendixes.

Scoring: Scoring shall be the Low Point System in Appendix A of the RRS. For the Racing and Cruising Divisions, all scores shall count. All divisions will be scored using time on time.

Awards: Prizes will be first through third place on corrected time for each fleet and an Overall winner.
